**(F) DESCRIPTION OF EXPOSURE AND REMARKS**

While responding to Box No. 0047 (the Deutsche Bank Building), I was ordered to operate on the \_\_\_\_\_ floors. The building was in the process of being demolished. At no time was I advised to or ordered by any superiors to operate outside normal firefighting standard operating procedures. It is now clear that I was exposed to the below toxins as soon as I stepped off the construction elevator. After my arrival, there was no supply of water for a very significant time as fire conditions worsened. When I ran out of air, I was again exposed to these same toxins and any toxins that were in the smoke of the burning material. I do not know the full extent of my exposure, but those substances included, but were not limited to, smoke and particulate matter from the Deutsche Bank and the WTC, asbestos, silicates, man-made vitreous fibers, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH's), PCB's, dioxins and heavy metals.
