# Fraternal Organization Scholarships

*Scholarships Offered by FDNY Fraternal Organizations*

## FDNY Columbia Association Scholarships

### Eligibility:

- Candidates for these awards may compete if a parent (natural, step or foster) is a member in good standing of the Columbia Association. Children of deceased members who were in good standing at time of death may also compete. Grandchildren are not eligible.

### Awards:

- High school awards for one male and one female student (each category): \$1,400, \$1,200, \$1,000
- College awards for one male and one female student (each category): \$1,500, \$1,000.
- Gerard Barbara Award: \$1,000 added to the scholarship for the 1<sup>st</sup> place male and female
- Legacy Advisors' Award: \$1,500 divided to all High School Awards.
- Rosina Maria Tornetta Higgins Award: \$200 additional for the highest SAT score.
- Marcello - Murphy Award: \$200 addition for highest STS score.

### Application:

- Applications are being accepted for Private or Public High School and College Awards and may be obtained online at [www.fdnycolumbia.com/scholarship/application](http://www.fdnycolumbia.com/scholarship/application), or from your Borough Trustee, or from the Scholarship Chairperson.

### Dates:

- Candidates for College Awards (12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students) typically submit applications with a copy of the candidate's SAT scores before April 1. These tests must be taken in the candidates' junior or senior year of high school. This must be during the candidates' graduating year.
- Candidates for High School Awards (8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students) typically submit applications before March 1. The STS Closed High School Placement is typically given the first weekend in March.
- Awards are presented at Annual Scholarship Dinner Dance at Russo's on the Bay in Howard Beach.

## FDNY Emerald Society Annual Scholarships

### Eligibility:

- Sons, daughters, brothers & sisters of Emerald Society members in good standing (must have been dues paying member for 3 years) who will be graduating from 8<sup>th</sup> grade or Junior HS by September are eligible.

### Awards:

- The FDNY Emerald Society awards 5 scholarships for \$1,500 each.

### Application:

- Applications are available online or from Borough Officers or Company Delegates and must be mailed to the Scholarship Chairman.

### Dates:

- The Annual Scholarship Examination takes place on the first Saturday in March and is required for application.
- Awards are given in May.

## **FDNY Hispanic Society Scholarship**

### **Eligibility:**

- Children of members of the FDNY Hispanic Society who are in good standing for a minimum of 2 years and are of Hispanic heritage are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be in high school with a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent, or in an undergraduate program in an accredited institution of higher learning with a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.

### **Awards:**

- The number of awards distributed varies. Each award is \$1,000.

### **Dates:**

- Applications are due prior to September of that year.
- Awards are presented at the Annual Scholarship Dinner Dance in October.

## **FDNY Holy Name Society High School Scholarship Exam**

### **Eligibility**

- Sons and daughters, brothers, sisters, and grandchildren of Holy Name Society members in good standing (including deceased members in good standing at the time of their death) in their eighth year of elementary education who will be entering high school are eligible to apply.

### **Awards:**

- Two awards of \$1,500 per year for four years (Catholic High School attendance required) are distributed annually.
- A one-time \$2,000 Vincent A. McCarthy Scholarship Award (Catholic High School attendance NOT required) is distributed annually.
- A one-time \$1,500 Captain Larry Monachelli Award (Catholic High School attendance NOT required) is distributed annually.

### **Eligibility:**

- This also applies equally to deceased members who were in good standing at time of death.

### **Awards:**

- The Higher Education Scholarship consists of two \$1,500 awards payable to any college or trade school of the winner's choice.

## **FDNY Saint George Association**

### **Eligibility:**

- Children, grandchildren and great grandchildren of active, retired or deceased members who are/were in good standing are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- There are four categories of awards: Ages 12 -13, Ages 14-15, Ages 16-17, and Ages 18-19

### **Awards:**

- Each award varies from \$100-\$500.

## **FDNY Steuben Association**

### **Eligibility:**

- Children, stepchildren and siblings of an active, retired or deceased firefighter who is/was a paid-up member of the Steuben Association for at least 3 years are eligible to apply for this award.
- Applicant must be completing 8<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

### **Awards:**

- Multiple awards for both high school and college receipts are distributed.
  - Four scholarships of \$200 each are awarded to 8<sup>th</sup> Grade winners, 2 males and 2 females.
  - Four scholarships of \$500 each are awarded to 12<sup>th</sup> Grade winners, 2 males and 2 females.
- Winners will take a picture at the award presentation and submit a short biography to be posted on the Steuben website for one year,
