Additional First Dose COVID-19 Vaccination Appointments Added

Additional 1st Dose COVID-19 Vaccination appointments have been made available on the Learning Management System (LMS).

Appointment Dates:

• Appointments will be available from Wednesday, January 27, 2021, to Monday, February 1, 2021.

Eligibility:

• At this time, due to supply shortages, the Department can only offer vaccinations to active-duty members and retirees who are over 65 years of age and who are also part of the FDNY WTC Health Program.

Scheduling:

- All appointments must be created in the Learning Management System (LMS).
