New COVID-19 Vaccination First Dose Appointments

Additional 1st dose vaccination appointments are now available through Monday, February 22, 2021.

Eligibility

- Active-Duty Members
- Retired Members over 65 enrolled in the WTC Health Program
- **WTC Health Program retirees under age 65 with a WTC-certified physical health condition are also eligible. Priority is being given to WTC retirees, regardless of age, who fall into any one of the following categories: requires oxygen 24/7, transplant recipients, treated for cancers within the last five years (those with ONLY basal or squamous skin cancers are excluded for now), or are currently being treated for an autoimmune disease.**

Registration

Reminders

- Members who previously declined the COVID-19 vaccination are still eligible to receive it. A member can log into LMS, select “Accept”, and then schedule their vaccination appointment.
