SCHOLARSHIPS – Our society grants five awards to highest scores and one Scholarship Drawing.

Two cash awards of \$1,500.00 per year for four years toward tuition only, paid directly to any Roman Catholic High School of the winners' choice.

Also, there is one endowed scholarship for one third tuition towards Fordham Preparatory High School in the Bronx. This endowed scholarship is for boys only.

We created the **Vincent A. McCarthy Award** for \$2,000.00, a one time cash award for one year. We also created the **Larry A. Monachelli Award** for \$1,500.00, a cash award for one year. (You will not be required to attend Catholic High School, but you will be required to take the test).

We created the **President's Award** for \$1,200.00. A single drawing, including all test applicants who sat for test and did not win one of the five awards. Member must be present to win.

ELIGIBILITY – Sons and daughters, brothers and sisters and grandchildren of members in good standing in this society, in their eighth year of elementary education. This also applies equally to deceased members who were in good standing at time of death

EXAMINATION – Test is solely for the purpose of determining winners of our scholarship program. It is not acceptable as an entrance examination to high school. Winners will have to arrange for acceptance into the high school of their choice. In the event of tying scores, application number will determine the winner.
