FDNY MEMORIAL DAY

The annual FDNY Memorial Day Ceremony will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, October 12, 2022, at the Firemen's Monument on Riverside Drive in Manhattan in honor of deceased members of the FDNY.

In addition to the Department's Memorial Day Service, the following borough collations will also be held on October 12:

BRONX / MANHATTAN

The 6th and 7th Division Collation, hosted by Engine 84 / Ladder 34 / Engine 67, will be held from 12:00 PM – 7:00 PM at the Hispanic Society Museum Pavilion, located between 155th + 156th Streets, at 3755 Broadway in Manhattan. Cost of \$25 per person includes wristband, mug and t-shirt. There will also be a 50/50 raffle, auction, cigars and live music by the Russo Brothers. Bus parking will be available on 155th Street from St. Nicholas Ave to Riverside Drive. MANHATTAN

The Manhattan Memorial Day Collation hosted by Engine 1 / Engine 26 / Ladder 24 and Engine 47 / Engine 74 / Ladder 25 for the 1st and 3rd Divisions will follow immediately after the Memorial Day Ceremony at Ellington in the Park, located at Riverside Park and 105th Street.
