

This first-of-its-kind experience set in the heart of New York City's Time Square will feature FRCF's "Roll Call of Heroes" program which recognizes real-life heroes on a national stage with a representative from each category of first responders on behalf of all first responders. The individual representing each category of first responder will be honored for their personal heroism and receive an award on behalf of all first responders in their respective field.

First responders from California, Florida, New Jersey, New York, Tennessee, Texas, and across the country will be invited to be honored, including: firefighters battling fires in California, Search and Rescue teams from Louisiana, and COVID-19 response EMTs in New York City. "Roll Call of Heroes" recipients have gone above and beyond the call of duty and risked their lives to rescue others in their communities. They are true heroes who represent the service and sacrifice of all in their profession.

To help us celebrate these honorable men and women on National First Responders Day, FRCF has planned a spectacular venue of performers, speakers, and presentations. We will invite A-List entertainers from the stage, screen, and music industry as well as provide speaking opportunities and brand activations for Title Sponsors at the event. Guest will include senior leadership from local, state, and federal first responder agencies from around the country.

Proceeds from the event will support FRCF programs including college scholarships, direct financial assistance, bereavement assistance, and toys during the holidays. Proceeds will also support mental health services for children of first responder families through the newly introduced First Responders Children's Foundation Resiliency Program.
