Health & Dental Benefits Transfer Period Now Open November 1 - November 30

HEALTH BENEFITS TRANSFER PERIOD

All members are advised that the City Transfer Period for the Health Benefits Program will run from November 1st – November 30th. This transfer period applies to both active and retired members. The health plan changes requested during this transfer period will become effective January 1, 2025. During the annual transfer period, members may transfer into any health plan for which they are eligible, add or drop the Optional Rider, and add or drop dependent(s). Members are reminded to update their dependents during this time.

DENTAL BENEFITS CHANGEOVER PERIOD

All members, active and retired, are advised that the MetLife Dental Changeover period will also run from November 1st – November 30th. During this time, members can switch between the Dental HMO (Managed Care Plan) and Dental PPO (PDP Plan) plans, with changes becoming effective January 1, 2025.
